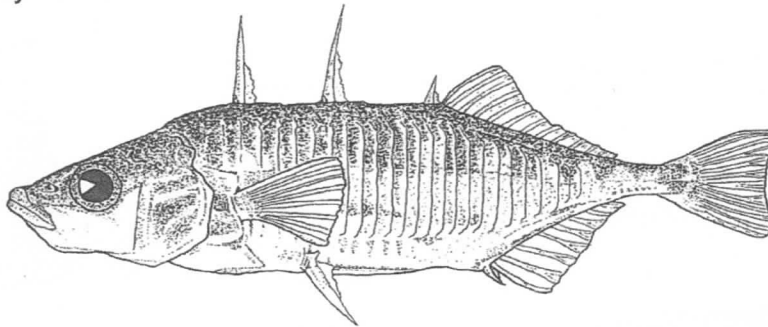
Stickleback Field Trip

Pine Creek

This is an opportunity to see one of San Diego's very few native fresh water fish, the Threespine stickleback. Pine Creek is one of the last places where these fish can be easily found.

We will meet at the Pine Creek Trailhead, which has parking and bathrooms, at 10:00 am. This is National Forest land and you will need a Forest Adventure Pass or Golden Age Passport to park here. Long pants are recommended, as we may need to walk through light brush. Also, there is some poison oak and stinging nettle in the area. After the field trip, if people are interested, we will stop at Mark & Arlene Ferguson's home in Guatay (about 1 1/2 miles away at 27225 Old Highway 80).
